The following enrichment classes will be offered for the Fall 2009. All classes will be held from 2.50 pm – 3.45 pm.

Hip Hop, Grades 6-8

Get into the groove and learn some moves. Learn all the latest choreography used in music videos and dance to your favorite artists with an experienced dance instructor from Stagestruck Kids Performing Arts Studio. Dress to dance in comfortable clothes and sneakers.

Mondays, beginning September 21st through November 16th (no class October 12th). Cost: \$100 for 8 weeks.

Aviation Club, Grades K-2

Come fly with us again or for the first time! Build new and exciting model airplanes from scratch with an instructor from Hobby Quest. Each student will learn all of the tools to create their own plane, learn the basics of aviation and watch their plane take flight. You will also learn the history, aerodynamics, physics and properties of flight and even conduct aviation experiments. All materials will be provided. Class size is limited.

Basketball Skills, Grades 3-4, one each for Girls and Boys

Color Me Mine Pottery, Grades K-3

Each week your child will paint and keep a piece of pottery. The final class will be a mosaic art piece, which they will also bring home. All supplies will be provided. Class taught by an instructor from Color Me Mine Pottery in Summit.
